Supervision enables understanding and orientation in clinical situations and also offers a support for belonging to the professional community's ongoing developments in order to offer the best practice to clients.

This training provides an education in the competencies necessary for working as a supervisor from a Gestalt therapy perspective. The comprehensive educational program consists of both theoretical and skills training. Each seminar develops a specific aspect of the supervision work with a theoretical frame and its practical applications, in a spiral process for the assimilation of competencies.

Among the program's topics we focus on specific supervisor's tasks and the difference between the competences of supervisors and those of psychotherapists. We build on the support gained from the experiential and theoretical knowledge of diagnosis and psychopathology. We also focus on ethics, contract and settings, case formulation and parallel processes from a field perspective. In the group setting, where participants come from different countries and different

Gestalt therapy traditions, we also learn from each other. Participants not only become supervisors trained in the contemporary Gestalt therapy approach, they also experience belonging to the colourful and creative international community, and enjoy the beauty of the two twin 'magic cities', Torino and Prague.

Entry requirements:

Gestalt therapists, or psychotherapists from other modalities, with at least 8 years of experience.

Ongoing requirements:

Reading, reflecting on the implementation of the theory learned from the seminar and from the reading into one's supervision practice, report on the next seminar. At least one publication or a presentation in a conference or workshop. Hypervision (not included in the seminars): 25 hours of hypervision to be done locally (at least 6 individually).

Final requirements:

To show the competences as supervisor (discussion and feedback on a session's video).
